BY-LAWS

ARTICLE IV

Ecclesiastical Matters

Sec. 7 Meetings of the Session or Board of Deacons may be conducted in person or by telephone conference call, videoconference or other synchronous electronic communication methods.

ARTICLE X - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec.1. Notice of the time, place, and purpose of all meetings of the congregation and of all meetings of the members of the corporation shall be publicly announced from the pulpit on the two successive Sundays next preceding the day of such meeting. Such meetings may be conducted in person or by telephone conference call, videoconference or other synchronous electronic communication methods.
