Through cloud and sunshine, O abide with me.

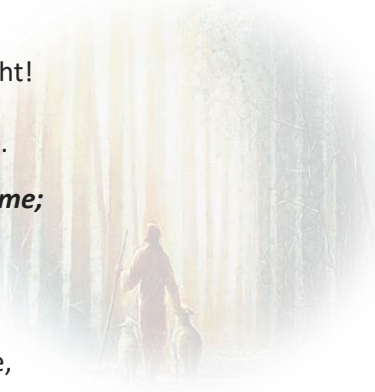
Hold thou thy cross before my closing eyes.
