ASH WEDNESDAY – February 26th

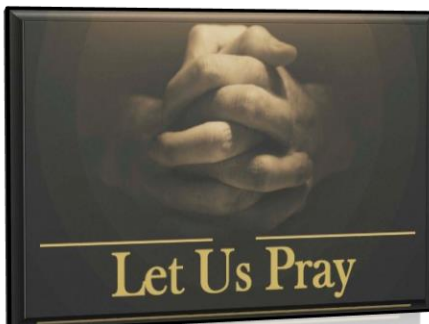
Looking ahead, in just a few weeks we will gather for Ash Wednesday. CPC will be having an evening service with the imposition of ashes at 7:00pm.
