Like many Presbyterians, you may have wondered, "*Exactly what does per capita do?*" Per capita is the set amount of money, per member, that our congregation remits to our Presbytery that is then sent onto our Synod and the General Assembly.

*Said another way, it is like a Presbyterian community fund —
part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together.*

We ask that each of you prayerfully consider contributing your share of Per Capita which has remained the same as last year, \$34.79 per member.
