is a six-week ministry of encouragement, organized by our Deacons, which encourages us to pray for our brothers and sisters within our congregation.

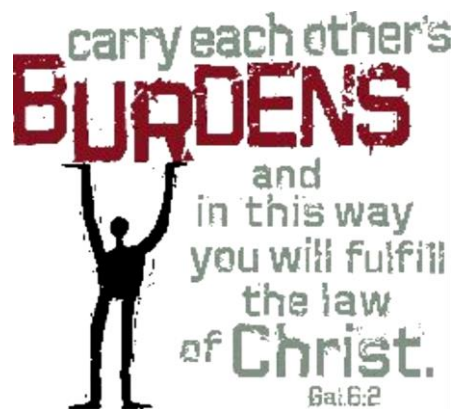
If you would like to have someone hold you in prayer during the Lenten Season, March 6 through April 14, you may complete the paper included below.

On March 3, those who are willing to pray for a Secret Prayer Pal will draw one of the names submitted. You may or may not know the person for whom you are praying – but God does. You are encouraged to pray each day for your Prayer Pal.

How should you pray for your Prayer Pal when you don't know any specific information about their needs? Pray for God's protection in general, pray for God's peace pray for God's action in their lives to be revealed. Don't worry if you don't know – God knows.

Remember this is a SECRET, so refrain from telling others who you are praying for – especially your Secret Prayer Pal!

At the end of the program, on Sunday, April 14, you may reveal your identity to your Secret Prayer Pal before or after worship, OR you may remain anonymous and keep the secret.
