

Like many Presbyterians, you may have wondered, *“Exactly what does per capita do?”* Per capita is the amount of support, per member, that our congregation remits to our Presbytery that is then sent onto our Synod and the General Assembly. This money is part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together. It is the money that enables us to work with other Presbyterian churches in our Presbytery and across the country. It is also money that allows us to work with other churches to further the mission of Jesus Christ around the world. The amount of Per Capita for 2020 is \$34.79, per member. You can pay in one payment or break it up in ways that fit your budget. Thank you to all of you who have already paid your share for 2020.

### **WINTER WEATHER ANNOUNCEMENT**


