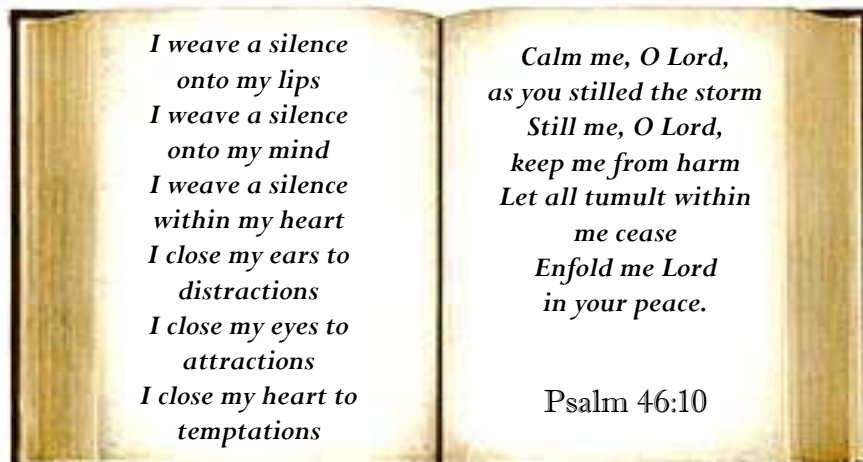

The reconciling work of Jesus was the supreme crisis in the life of humankind.
