#### AFFIRMATION of FAITH † Confession of 1967

The Lord's Supper is a celebration of the reconciliation of humanity with God and with one another, in which they joyfully eat and drink together at the table of their Savior. Jesus Christ gave his church this remembrance of his dying for sinful people so that by participation in it they have communion with him and with all who shall be gathered to him.
