PRELUDE

CALL to WORSHIP † OPENING HYMN

This litany interweaves Martin Luther's great Reformation hymn with the words from Scripture that inspired it, the words of Psalm 46.

Leader: God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

ALL: Therefore, we will not fear, though the earth should change, though the mountains shake in the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble with its tumult.

ALL SING:

*A mighty fortress is our God, a bulwark never failing;
our helper he amid the flood of mortal ills prevailing.
For still our ancient foe doth seek to work us woe;
his craft and power are great, and, armed with cruel hate,
on earth is not his equal.*

Leader: There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High.

ALL SING:

*Did we in our own strength confide, our striving would be losing;
were not the right man on our side,
